With this launch, the total bed capacity of the hospital has now expanded to **220 beds**.

In recent years, the hospital recognised a critical reality: paediatric care in India must move beyond routine treatment and embrace the depth of specialised and clinically advanced multidisciplinary medicine.

While families may be aware of routine childhood ailments, a range of complex paediatric conditions—such as congenital heart diseases, neurological disorders, and kidney-specific illnesses—necessitate early detection, advanced, high-precision diagnostics and harmonised specialist care.

The new centre is purpose-built to bridge this gap, ensuring that every child—from newborns to adolescents—has access to the right expertise at the right time, all under one integrated roof. It is supported by an advanced paediatric surgical ecosystem that includes a specialised Paediatric Cath Lab, dedicated Paediatric Cardiac surgery OT, Paediatric Dialysis unit. The facility is further strengthened by cutting-edge diagnostic technology, including a 160-slice CT scanner and a 1.5 Tesla MRI, both specially configured to meet the unique needs of the paediatric age group.

A paediatric hospital cannot simply be a scaled-down version of an adult facility because children require age-appropriate environments, Paediatric age-tailored medical technologies, and clinicians trained to understand their unique needs. Guided by this philosophy, the new hospital integrates advanced subspecialties including:

- Paediatric Cardiology
- Paediatric Nephrology
- Paediatric Neurology

- Paediatric Gastroenterology
- Paediatric Surgery
- Paediatric Urology
- Paediatric Orthopaedics

The Neonatal Critical care Unit (NICU), Paediatric Critical care Unit (PICU), paediatric emergency services, and technologically advanced operating theatres are complemented by child-friendly interiors, sensory-aware environments, and dedicated age-specific zones thoughtfully designed for new-borns, infants, children, and adolescents.

Every design and clinical decision reflects Ambuja Neotia's broader purpose: to create environments that nurture healing, comfort families, and uphold dignity during moments of vulnerability.
