Uplifting Healthcare in Guwahati

The year marked a significant milestone for Ambuja Neotia Healthcare Venture Limited with the launch of the **100-bed Neotia Bhagirathi Woman and Child Care Centre (NBWCCC) Guwahati**, on 5 June 2025. The facility was **inaugurated by Assam Chief Minister Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma** in the presence of **Mr. Harshavardhan Neotia** and **Mr. Parthiv Neotia**.

Established to provide advanced and accessible healthcare for women, mothers and children across Assam and the North-East, the hospital offers specialised services in obstetrics, gynaecology, neonatology, paediatrics, IVF and more, supported by modern infrastructure and expert medical professionals.

Over the past year, NBWCCC Guwahati has actively promoted healthcare awareness, education and community engagement through numerous successful initiatives.

A Continuing Medical Education (CME) session on "Targeting Right Nutrition for Better Neurodevelopmental Outcome" was organised on 8 August 2025, highlighting the role of early nutrition in brain development. During World Breastfeeding Week (1-7 August 2025), the hospital conducted a Poster Display Competition to encourage informed breastfeeding choices and stronger support for mothers.

On 5 September 2025, another **CME programme** addressed topics such as congenital infections during pregnancy and evolving guidelines for PCOS management. **National Nutrition Week** was also celebrated with a cooking competition promoting nutrition awareness and traditional food practices.

Professional development remained a priority through programmes such as **LaMBCon 2025**, an Advanced Lactation Skills workshop, **the NNF Nursing Zonal Quiz** organised with **NNF Assam**, and a **CME session on Recent Advances in Neonatology** led by Dr. Rajib Losan Bora.



Community outreach formed an important part of the hospital's mission. An **Obstetrics and Gynaecology Awareness Health Camp** was conducted in January 2026, while health check-up programmes were organised at Ekalavya Modern Academy and Maharishi Kids Home to promote preventive healthcare among children.

The hospital also launched **"Care Kotha,"** a community-focused medical talk show addressing **"Anaemia, nutrition during pregnancy and fertility planning"**. A special Mother's Day edition centred on the theme **"Safe Motherhood: Safe Maa, Strong Future."**

A major achievement was the **inauguration of the IVF Department** on 12 March 2026, providing comprehensive fertility services with advanced technology. **World Health Day 2026** was observed through free consultations for women and antenatal exercise awareness sessions.

The year also featured a **Scientific Symposium on Obstetrics and Gynaecology**, where experts discussed emerging challenges in women's health, fertility care and maternal well-being.

Recognising its commitment to compassionate care, clinical excellence and community service, NBWCCC Guwahati received **the prestigious Ankuram Excellence Award 2026**. As it moves forward, the hospital remains dedicated to enhancing healthcare standards for women and children across the region.
